MEMORIAL REGULATIONS

- . **LAWN SECTIONS:** Upon purchase of the Exclusive Right the owner is permitted to place a memorial headstone restricted in size. The maintenance of the grounds around the headstone is the responsibility of the Council. In order to maintain an ordered and uniformed appearance within the lawn sections, the placing of any ornaments, chippings, edgings, fencing or plants of any descriptions outside the confines of the headstone and plinth, is not permitted.
- . All memorials and inscriptions are at the approval and discretion of the Authority. Particular attention must be paid to the right of ownership of the applicant as well as to the plot or grave number.
- . All memorials placed upon cremation plots or graves must have the reference number clearly inscribed.
- . The above will also apply to any memorial removed for whatever reason if subsequently returned to the Cemetery.
- . As from 1st April 2009, applications for erection of Memorials will only be accepted from Masons registered with BRAMM. At least 1 Fixer erecting the memorial must hold a current BRAMM 'Fixers' licence, and after undertaking the work must be complete and return Part 'B' of the Permit to Erect a Monument' form to the Cemetery Superintendent.
- . No memorial work is to be undertaken without a written permit/receipt being issued by the TONYREFAIL & DISTRICT COMMUNITY COUNCIL.
- . It is required that overall dimensions of the proposed memorial is submitted with this application, including details of fixing methods.
- . The overall height of the memorial must include the dimensions of the headstone and base combined.
- . **It is strongly recommended that you have adequate memorial insurance cover. Advice on Memorial Insurance will be provided to the applicant by your Monumental Mason**

SIZES OF MEMORIALS PERMITTED AT TRANE CEMETERY

Memorials – Lawn Section

The concrete base can be to a maximum of 3ft. long, with 1 inch visible at its shallowest end, and no more than 18 inches wide.

The headstone can be to a maximum of 3ft. in height from the concrete base, and a maximum of 3ft. long.

Memorials – Cremation Section

Base 18 inches x 18 inches with container hole/holes to front
Raised sloping block/wedge to accommodate 15 inches x 15 inches x 1.1/2 inch plaque.
